

## **AKC Summer Intensive 2022 - Terms & Conditions**

Incomplete applications will not be accepted by the Company.

AKC cannot sponsor any visas. AKC can provide a letter of invitation for visa purposes.

AKC will bear the costs of the programme's tuition making this training programme free of charge for the cohort of selected dancers.

AKC will provide subsistence from Monday 15 August 2022 to Saturday 20 August 2022 (3 meals per day) for the cohort of selected dancers.

AKC will liaise with the cohort of selected dancers about accommodation options.

Selected dancers will cover their travel expenses to/from Belfast, UK as well as any COVID-19 related costs and any visa costs.

Selected dancers will sign a sworn statement to secure their spot on the programme.

Selected dancers agree to be vaccinated to the highest level possible and provide proof of any new booster vaccines option made available to them.

Selected dancers agree to comply with the country or venue's testing requirements at any point during the project. Any tests that are required will be arranged by the Company and covered by the participants themselves, including any mandatory tests needed on the return of the participants' country of residence.

AKC has the right to amend the programme's schedule and the artistic team.

In case of cancellation of the Summer Intensive by AKC, AKC cannot refund any invested travel expenses.

AKC will not be held responsible for any loss of or damage to participants' belongings or any types of injuries to participants that occur whilst attending the course. Participants will inform AKC about any past and/or present injuries.

The data collected in relation to the project will be used and shared only between AKC and The MAC Belfast for the sole purpose of the project. Should participants be interested in receiving further communication from AKC & The MAC, Belfast, they will have to sign indirectly on the websites.

Participants agree to be photographed and/or recorded on video for archival and publicity purposes of the Company. Participants cannot claim any rights of property regarding these materials.
